HEARING RE-SCHEDULED

REVISED NOTICE OF HEARING

Please be advised that the hearing previously scheduled for October 3, 2007, must be re-scheduled, because the statutorily required quorum of five cannot be established from the members designated to serve as the Hearing Board. For that reason, the hearing before that designated Hearing Board will be re-scheduled to be held on November 7, 2007. The formal notice to the parties is set forth below.

Please take notice that pursuant to the authority vested in the State of Vermont, Board of Medical Practice by Title 26, Chapters 7, 23 and 31, and by Title 3, Chapter 25, a hearing will be held before the Vermont Board of Medical Practice, Vermont Department of Health, at Gifford Memorial Hospital (Red Clover Room), Randolph, Vermont, on Wednesday, November 7, 2007 from 10:00 am until 12:00 noon. This hearing shall be held for the Board to consider the Hearing Committee Report filed on July 16, 2007, which sets forth Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and a Proposed Decision regarding the Amended Specification of Charges filed against David S. Chase, M.D., Respondent.


Respondent and the State have filed exceptions to the Hearing Committee Report with the Board on September 7, 2007, and may file reply exceptions on or before September 21, 2007. The parties may appear and present oral argument to the Board at the hearing on November 7, 2007. Each party shall have 30 minutes to address the Board. A record of the proceeding will be kept. At the conclusion of the hearing, the Board shall go into deliberative session to render judgment in the matter. The deliberative session shall be closed to the public in accordance with 3 V.S.A. § 312(e) and shall continue as necessary. The Board may accept, reject, or modify the findings and conclusions contained in Hearing Committee Report and shall render judgment on the findings and conclusions on the basis of the evidence in the record before it pursuant to 26 V.S.A. §§ 1355(b) and 1360(a).
