

SUMMARY

These intercensal population estimates for 1991-1999 for the towns and counties of Vermont, and the age-sex distribution of the counties, update and replace the postcensal estimates which have been published in the past decade. These new estimates are based on the 1990 and 2000 Census counts.

The Vermont population increased from 562,758 in 1990 to 608,827 in 2000, and increase of 46,069 (8.2%). The largest increase in population was seen in Chittenden County, an increase of 14,810 people (11.2%). The largest percentage increase was seen in Grand Isle County, where an increase of 1,583 people was a 29.8% increase from the 1990 population.

The age distribution of Vermont's population changed noticeably from 1990 to 2000. There was a decline in population aged less than 10, and from 20-34. The largest increase was seen in the population aged 45-59, though there were large increases in the over 70 population as well.

A description of the methods used to produce these estimates is included at the end of this report.
